





Average length of stay by month (nights)2




Average length of stay by month – Top four* market areas2



Which regions were visited in 2019⁵




Overall satisfaction by region 2019⁵

Results from the frequent surveys of Isavia 2017-2018 indicate, that the combined percentage of self-connecting passengers and foreign citizens living in Iceland varies between seasons but has been measured between 5.3%-10.4%.
